(Organize annual meeting/picnic. Susan Cramer and Corianne Sizemore, Picnic Co-Chairs; MaryAnn Eeds, Election Committee Chair)
 - **All-Neighborhood Yard sale(s)**
(Organize annual neighborhood yard sale(s). Nancy Parana and Bob Croft, Co-Chairs)
 - **Ice Cream Social/Parade**
(Organize annual ice cream social and parade. Susan Cramer and Corianne Sizemore, Co-Chairs)
 - **GAIN Breakfast**
(Coordinate annual GAIN breakfast with other sponsoring agencies. Susan Zbick)
- **Visual Award**
(Monthly award recognition for residents who excel in maintaining or improving exterior appearance of their properties. CJ Carezza)
- **Good Neighbor Award**
(Periodic award to neighboring businesses that enhance quality of life in downtown historic neighborhoods. Jonathan Mann)
- **Good Neighbors Program**
(Responsible for organizing responses to neighbors in need. Maryann Eeds, C.J. Carezza, Co-Chairs)
- **Block Watch/Law Enforcement (Including Graffiti)**
(Coordinates with law enforcement and neighbors to resolve neighborhood crime issues. Susan Zbick, Chair)

COMMUNICATIONS

- **Story Time**
(Responsible for monthly publication of STORY newsletter. Sharon Hunnicutt, Editor)
- **Web Page/Message Board**
(Responsible for maintenance and oversight of web page/message board. Pat Ten Eyck and CJ Carezza)
- **F.Q. Story Directory**
(Periodic update of F.Q. STORY Directory. Kelli Williamson, Editor)
- **"Pets Pal"**
(Maintains register of STORY dogs, cats and other critters that can be accessed in case of emergencies such as the loss or straying of a pet. Pat Ten Eyck)

NEIGHBORHOOD INFRASTRUCTURE

- **Lighting**
(Issues associated with present and future public lighting. Bob Croft, Chair)
- **Traffic Calming**
(Issues associated with neighborhood traffic. Cindy Dick, Chair)

- **Street/Alley/Water/Sewer Issues**
(Issues associated with maintenance/upkeep of streets, alleys, water mains, sewers, etc. Nancy Parana and Louisa Stark, Chairs)
- **Neighborhood Property Issues**
 - **Property Maintenance Issues**
(Issues associated with property upkeep)
 - **Historic Preservation Issues**
(Responds to historic preservation issues within STORY with focus on building construction and rehab.)
 - **Development Services Issues**
(Problems associated with building construction and rehab permits in Story)

EXTERNAL ISSUES

- **Zoning Issues**
(City of Phoenix zoning issues that may affect STORY neighborhood)
- **Historic Preservation Issues**
(City, State or local historic preservation issues that may affect STORY neighborhood)
- **Liquor Licenses**
(Responsibility for protesting liquor licenses that may negatively affect neighborhood. Louisa Stark)
- **Legislative Issues**
(Responsibility for legislative actions that may impact neighborhood)
- **Liasons**
(Purpose: To support STORY point of view as members of the following organizations.)
 - **Historic Districts Coalition**
(Focuses on issues of importance to local historic neighborhoods.)
 - **Downtown Voices Coalition**
(Coalition of downtown organizations that focuses on downtown redevelopment. Tim Eigo, Representative)
 - **Weed and Seed**
(STORY, along with 4 adjacent neighborhoods, is a member of the Capitol Weed and Seed Coalition which stresses increased law enforcement and community development. Tim Eigo and Louisa Stark, Representatives)
 - **McDowell Now**
(Organization of neighborhoods along McDowell Road between 19th Ave and 16th St. Focus on development of McDowell as gateway to downtown.)
 - **Grand Avenue Merchant's Association (GAMA)**
(Represents businesses along Grand Avenue between 7th and 19th Avenues. Grand Avenue, between 15th and 19th Avenues, forms the NE boundary of STORY. Tim Eigo and Louisa Stark, Representatives)
